

Entry requirements

Admission to the degree is the responsibility of the Master's Admissions Committee, and its decision will be final. To issue the evaluation result, the Committee will assess the documentation provided by the candidate:

- Academic record of the access degree
- Relevant fields of prior undergraduate study: Political Science and Public Administration, Marketing and Market Research, Private International Law, Public International Law and International Relations, Applied Economics, Financial Economics and Accounting, Business Management, International Political Economy, Economic Analysis, Engineering, Philosophy, Communication
- Proof of a B2 level in English
- Curriculum Vitae: previous postgraduate or continuing education related to the Master's program, prior professional experience, internships, knowledge of other languages, which must be evidenced with the submitted documentation

Motivation letter explaining why the candidate wishes to undertake the program, their professional objectives, attitudes, and values aligned with future professional activity in the field of business diplomacy. If deemed necessary, the Committee may conduct a personal interview.

The maximum score will be 100 points in total, and the evaluation of the presented merits will be based on the following weighting criteria:
