

Candidate Profile for the Master's Degree in International Business

To gain access to official Master's degree courses, students must hold an official Spanish university degree, or another degree issued by a higher education institution in the European Higher Education Area that entitles them to access Master's degree courses in the country issuing the degree.

Graduates from educational systems outside the European Higher Education Area may also be admitted without the need to have their degrees recognised, subject to verification by the University of Deusto that they accredit a level of education equivalent to the corresponding Spanish university degrees and that they are recognised in the country issuing the degree for access to postgraduate studies. In accordance with current legislation, access by this route does not imply, in any case, the homologation of the previous degree held by the person, nor its recognition for purposes other than that of studying these Master's Degrees.

The recommended profile for admission to the Master in International Business is the following:

- * who has previous training in the area of business management and administration or related disciplines.
- * who need advanced training in international business management.
- * who wish to develop their professional career abroad by developing internationalisation projects.
- * who values multicultural diversity and knows how to adapt to new environments.
- * who has the potential to lead business projects in the future.
- * advanced knowledge of English.

Access to the Master is open to any qualified person, without discrimination due to age, nationality, gender, race, religion, disability, sexual orientation, origin or any other condition. In addition to the access requirements dictated by current legislation and mentioned in the previous lines, an admission process is carried out that assesses jointly, and without any of them being in itself eliminatory, elements such as academic record, previous professional experience, command of English (level C1), knowledge of other languages and motivation to take the programme.
