- Be competent in **health education** and in the design of therapeutic interventions to promote physical activity and other healthy habits.
- Guide patients during the therapeutic process through **continuous assessment** and **reassessment** in order to decide on the most appropriate methods and procedures to be applied.
- **Maximise research** in physiotherapy to foster professional activities based on scientific evidence.
- **Reflect** critically on different scientific, clinical, ethical aspects of the profession, among others.
