The Bachelor's Degree in Medicine is designed to produce medical professionals in accordance with the main needs required by general medical practice in the coming decades. The aim is to promote and restore health by developing medical professionals capable of prescribing and implementing activities aimed at health promotion, maintenance and recovery.

Furthermore, the Medicine degree **trains and prepares students to prevent illnesses**, taking into account the social environment in which they originate, for the **diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of patients** and the **assessment and prognosis of the processes** being treated.

As medical education is a key instrument for professional practice, the project presented by the University of Deusto is oriented towards **meeting the social health needs** (the doctors that society need). Effective medical education should provide the foundations for further training in any of the branches of medicine, in accordance with doctors' role in the health care system, also in accordance with our laws and social demands.

Therefore, this degree takes into account doctors' **social responsibility**, their **research training**, their **involvement with the community** in which they will work and the relationship with **postgraduate medical training**. Likewise, the Bachelor's Degree in Medicine aims to provide patient-focused training, and is also focused on the research skills of future graduates and on supporting internationalisation.
