

## Requirement profile: Bachelor's degree in International Relations

This Bachelor's degree programme has been designed for students who possess a particular sensitivity to global issues and wish to pursue a career in different areas of international organisations, or in businesses and institutions that operate in international contexts. The programme is therefore oriented towards students interested in knowing and critically analysing not only the world around them but also new global frameworks and their increasingly complex, intercultural and interdependent nature.

This demanding degree programme is taught in Spanish and English, which means that the same subjects are not offered in both languages of instruction. Students are therefore required to have approximately a C1 level of English, which is checked in the Faculty's entrance exams. Other types of reasoning (abstract, verbal, etc.) are also measured to ensure candidates have the competences that are central to UD students, such as critical thinking, the capacity for teamwork or interpersonal communication.
